

PROCLAMATION

Mr. Monserrate J. Guillen Saez, Lord Mayor and President of the Town Hall Orihuela

Informs You

Under the provision of art. 26.n) of the Municipal Ordinance regarding Tenure and Protection of Animals dated June 24, 2008 it is prohibited to feed abandoned animals, especially cats and dogs, on public property and in public areas, these areas having been determined as such areas based on technical reports regarding safety and public health. In the case of animals being fed in public areas dry food should be used and the affected areas should be cleaned afterwards.

The following information is from the Municipal Veterinary Department

IT IS PROHIBITED

UNDER THE APPROPRIATE SANCTION TO FEED COLONIES OF FERAL CATS WHERE THERE IS A NATURAL INFLUX OF PARTICULARLY SENSITIVE INDIVIDUALS SUCH AS CHILDREN, PREGNANT WOMEN OR PEOPLE WITH IMMUNE PROBLEMS, PARTICULARLY IN SCHOOLS, PLAYGROUNDS, HEALTH CENTRES AND THEIR VICINITY.
